## DANCING TIPS by ERIC WENDELL . . . QLD SUBMITTED FOR YOUR INTEREST

### FYI — Press Release to all SD Publications

In October 1990 many clubs and callers received a mailing from Broadcast Music Inc (BMI) offering contracts for the use of copyrighted music. The proposed rate for these licenses was \$15 per dance. Responding to the uproar of concern that resulted, CALLERLAB and ROUNDALAB entered into negotiations with BMI. The goal was to arrange a licensing agreement that would be reasonable in cost and would relieve the individual clubs from the responsibility for the license, thus reducing overall costs for the entire Square Dance Activity.

BMI is one of the two major associations that administer copyright control for the composers and publishers of music. The other is the American Society of Composer, Authors and Publishers (ASCAP). These two associations are the legal representatives of the composers of most of the music you hear today and most of the singing calls and round dance tunes used in the square and round dance activities. Patter call music is often in the public domain which means it is old enough to no longer be covered by copyright or it was never covered under copyright in the first place. CALLERLAB and ROUNDALAB representatives are nearing completion of negotiations with both organizations. Licenses will be issued through the two organizations to callers and round dance leaders who are members of their respective organizations. Use of licensed leaders will relieve the clubs of the obligation to have a license for regular club dances, workshops and classes.

Callers and round dance leaders who are members of either organizations will receive information about licensing through their professional organization. If you wish to learn more about membership requirements, please contact:

Any club whose regular caller(s) or cuer(s) are not already members of the two professional organizations for callers and cuers (CALLERLAB and ROUNDALAB) might want to encourage their callers and cuers to join in order to assure that they meet the legal requirement for licensed use of music. All clubs are encouraged to consider helping the dance leaders to cover the increased cost of this recently discovered legal requirement. The added cost to each caller or cuer will be substantial depending on the frequency of performance and membership status.

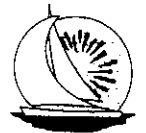

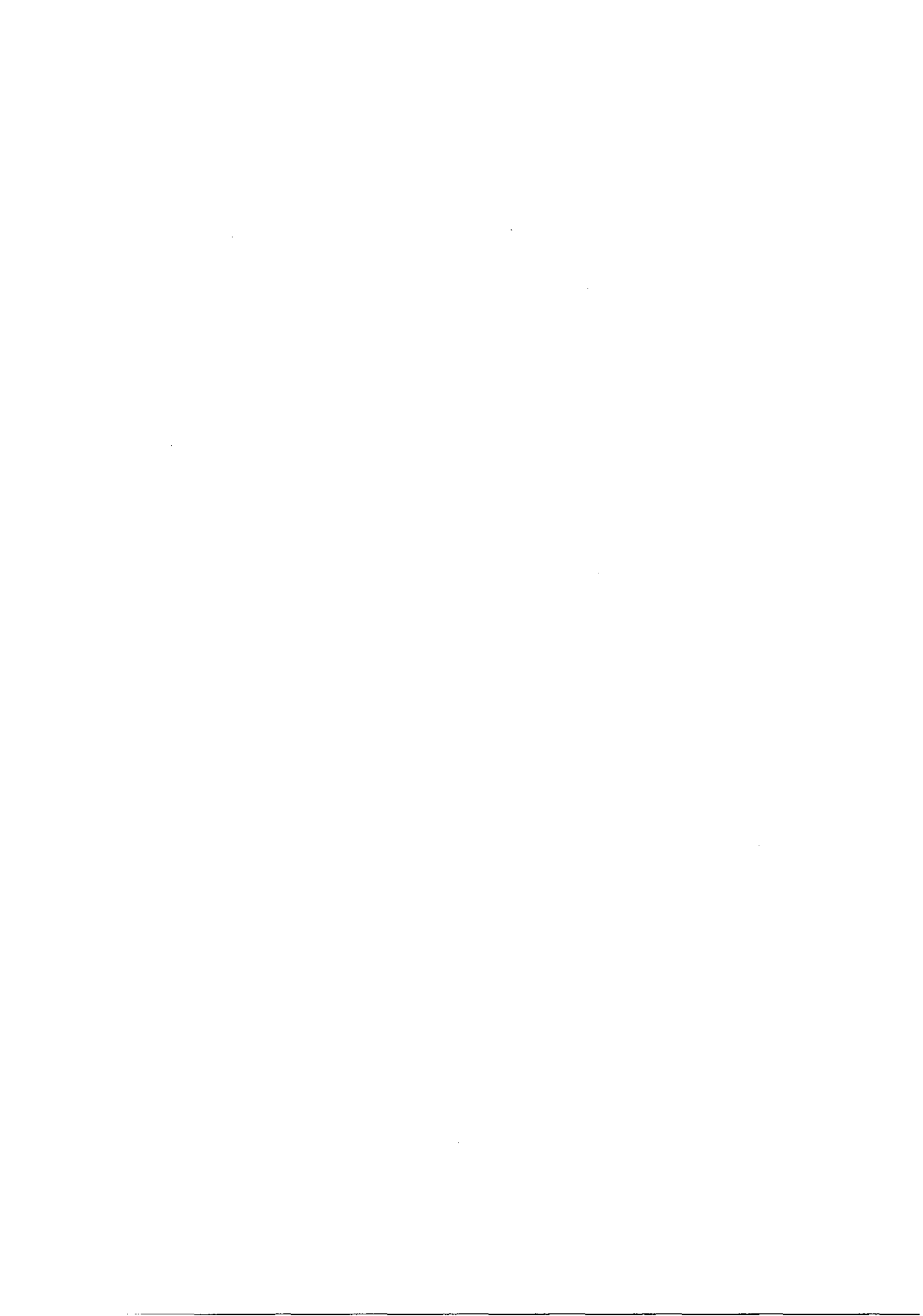

## KNOW YOUR ROUND DANCING

Well this is the last chance that I will be able to mention the RD Education Sessions to be held at the Melbourne National Convention. Therefore I want to devote this whole article to explaining them.

There is two sessions Thursday afternoon and Monday morning. The Thursday session is for Teachers and Callers (or a representative) and the Monday session is for everybody. Both are free, have Tea and Coffee provided and are at the Penthouse Hotel, about 5 minutes from the venue where the meetings and meals are, so the address will be in your programs. But both have different topics and levels and are aimed at different people.

I'll only give a brief run down on each session. The first part will be presented by Ron and Ella Whyte. It will be a many pointed type of session, covering such things as, History of RDing in Aust, Running a club together, How to introduce RDing into a SD club etc. Questions will be most encouraged in this session.

The second part on Thursday will be presented by Carl and Nola on Latin movements from Phase III and a little from Phase IV. This will be a follow up from last year. This will be replaced next year by another topic with other presenters so if you missed it last year this is your last chance for a while.

Callers who can not get to the Convention or don't have the time to use much RDing in their club can send an interested person or couple. The first part of Thursday is es-

pecially useful here and it is on first so that those not needing Latin (Rumba, Cha Cha or Jive) yes can get away early for meals etc.

The Monday sessions will be more dancer orientated and will deal with lower level, dance material. It is also free in a sense, as you have paid for it in your registration. It is part of the convention program. So do come along and see what knowledge you can pick up.

The first part will be presented by Jim and Jean Parsons and will deal with some Tango and Foxtrot from Phase III and possibly Phase IV. The second part will deal with Waltz movements from Phase II and III. This will be presented by Nev and Bev McLachlan.

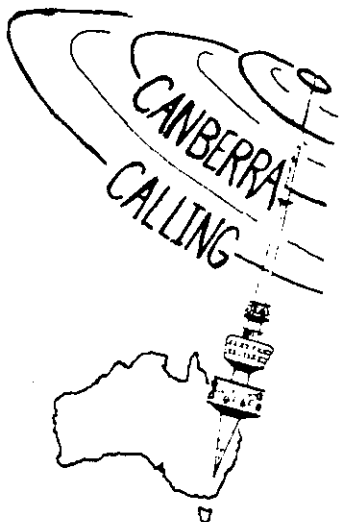

# WORKSHOP With Eric Wendell Queensland

## LOAD THE BOAT BUT THE CENTERS GO 3/4 OR 3 & 1/2

Directing the centers of the Load The Boat to go 3/4 tells the dancers to do 3 of the 4 actions that make up the centers part of Load The Boat. The four parts being . . . 1. Pass Thru. 2. Turn your back to partner. 3. Do a Partner Trade. 4. Pass Thru. So by call for the centers to go 3/4 they will end in facing couples in the center leaving the ending formation in a Double Pass Thru Formation. If you call for the centers to go 3 & 1/2, they will end in a wave thru the center or the ending formation becomes a 1/4 Tag Formation. A few ideas, all from standard lines.

NOW, the ends of the starting line can also be directed to Load The Boat 3/4, or 3 & 1/2 . . . Combine this with the fractional centers action and you will add to the flavour of this type of directional calling.

ZERO LINE . . . LOAD THE BOAT . . . 3/4 . . . CTRS STAR THRU . . . (Facing lines) CTRS. SQUARE THRU 4 . . . ENDS STAR THRU . . . PASS THE OCEAN . . . GIRLS TRADE . . . RECYCLE . . . LEFT ALLE . . . Zero line . . .

## THE PLUS PROGRAM: EXPERIMENTAL WORKSHOP:

**TEACUP STROLL:** Ben Risinger. Ben is a dancer in Tampa Fl.

**STARTING FORMATION:** A static Square.

**THE ACTION:** As in a Teacup Chain the Head Ladies move to the center for a 3/4 right hand star. The head men will then move one position to their right and turn original partner into a roll promenade position. Meanwhile the side couples will promenade one position to their right and then as new head couples put their partner into the center for a 3/4 star and then the original side men will move to the next position to their right to meet their original partner for a roll promenade as the original head couples (new sides) will promenade one position to their right to become a head couple . . . Continue this pattern until all dancers return to home. To condense the action, the dancers at the head positions will put the ladies in the center for a 3/4 star, then promenade to their right one position to meet original partner for a roll promenade to the next position to their right. Side couples will promenade to their right one position to become head couples and then put their partners into the center for a 3/4 star etc. A nice 32 beat figure.

**ENDING FORMATION:** Static square at home.

**NOTE:** The call moves nicely and other than never changing partners it is a simple but fun call that will be fun for a while or at a weekend. If the girls use nice skirt work the Teacup Stroll will make a nice exhibition figure. Try it with the San Antonio Stroll . . .
