As I write this it is the start of square dance month, (March) and as I did last year for square dance month, I have written to a lot of local newspapers and local radio stations. The response from the radio segments last year was very good so I'm now waiting to see what this year's response will be.

During the last couple of weeks I've had phone calls from many local councils as they are updating their contact lists. It is very important to keep these sort of lists up to date. The same goes for the Society's listing we have of clubs and their contacts. As many of you will be aware the diary listing in the review is now an option to each individual club to decide upon. For those clubs dropping out of that list it does not mean we do not want to know you. I would still like to have a full list of clubs and contacts in N.S.W. The list I use is the one we send to America to be included in the international square dance directory. So please keep me up to date of any change in your club or contact so that this list can be kept as up to date as possible. The closing date for the 1992 American international directory is August and that means we have to have our list ready to send to the United States by the end of July 1991. I will be at our state convention and you may check your listing with me if you wish. Registration on the American listing is free so don't let this advertising opportunity pass you by.

Demonstrations are in demand at the moment. K and K rounds are to do one for the Holroyd festival later this month and Dick and Mavis are organising one for a local hospital in the near future. The Sparklates square dance club are taking part in an information day during April which is being put on by Hornsby Council. All these functions came about because of the Society's listing with the local councils. It is all free publicity and the more non dancers see about our activity the more chance we have of spreading the word and collecting new dancers.

I've had a few other enquiries for demonstrations but I was unable to get groups to do these. It's very hard to organise a set of dancers for a day time demonstration. If there is a group out there that is able and willing to help please let me know. Most of these demos are for local hospitals and nursing homes so you do not have to be a competition style dancer to do these demonstrations. If you are, then great. but so long as you enjoy dancing and the people can see the pleasure you get out of it then they will enjoy it as well.

LETTERS TO THE EDITOR

"Regarding loss of club attendance and membership"

The Square Dance Society must reorganise and insist that all callers, in particular and certainly all floor members of their clubs become members of the Society and abide by its rules.

Some floor members who are active in their clubs and as visitors to support other local clubs frequently discuss square dancing, its highlights and its shortcomings.

Personally, I have come in contact with more callers who are not members of the Society for various given reasons; two of which seem to crop up frequently.

The first is discontent, the second apparent alleged favouritism and biased decisions by the Association. The consequence is they do not espouse the virtues of being Association members, they are not enthusiastic or interested in the Society and do not enthruse their members to join the Association.

These callers tend to make their own club rules and even teach beginners and others differently to Association callers. The result is when these members visit they dance differently, upset their square as far as legitimate dancers are concerned.

I agree with the remarks of "Letter To The Editor", Jan/Feb 1991 issue by Ron Jones and this letter is a floor member's views and experiences in regard to his comments. Personally, I have been a regular square dancer for approximately 15 years.

Another reason for falling club attendances is that beginners should be able to join and be taught as individuals, i.e. Ladies or Men. Forget this "must join as partners of opposite sexes" of which they are informed on their first night's attendance and turned away for this stupid reason before spending one pleasant evening with us. They leave with rather a nasty taste and mostly never come back.

This is discrimination at its worst emanating from the dark ages and surely will be tested in the courts one day. When this day arrives, the Association, as the defendant will lose, the whole matter will be blown up by the media and will result in detrimental news coverage for the Association — we are already battling for any opportunity for media coverage to attract new members.

I always understood that clubs were supposed to be run by the callers as the hub, assisted by a steering club committee, for the benefit of square dancing generally and the club individually.

I observe a trend for some callers to run a multiple of clubs as a private business and not as an Association club. I appreciate the caller must be compensated and rightly so, but not as a business venture.

I consider a caller should be limited to permanently calling at two clubs and be content with guest calling at any other club should he or she be invited to do so.

Another matter pertains to the advertising of regular club dance nights which are cancelled without notice.

There is nothing that will turn a dancer off more than reserving an evening with the anticipation of visiting for a pleasant evening, getting suitably dressed, often driving or travelling considerable distances (a sign of good membership enthusiasm) only to find on arrival, the hall in darkness and void of any activity. Some of these ads in the Review have run for months without cancellation or amendment and urgent attention must be given to this matter by those concerned.

This letter is not intended as merely words of criticism but more in an endeavour to enhance square dancing for everyone's benefit.

How many times have we all heard and read the apparently hollow words:—

"Square Dancing is fun"

"Square Dancing makes friends"

"Bring a friend"

Let us improve and make these sentiments come true by better co-ordination, organisation and the rectification of matters mentioned and I feel sure membership and club attendances will improve.

Dear Editor,

In answer to the letter from Ron Jones. I feel that Mr Jones is correct in his remarks about weekends away and inter-club functions. I believe that clubs do need to interact, but probably three dances a year are quite sufficient, with the state and national conventions making almost a function every two months.

However, I also believe very strongly that club dancing is the way to go. With the satisfaction of a good night's dancing comes the fellowship and social interaction under the direction of a caller who is personally interested and caring towards his dancers. Dancers have the precious feeling of belonging and are able to help one another through the difficulties of the dance and share the pleasure of fun and laughter while doing so.

Many people with no club affiliation, while getting many nights of dancing from place to place are, I feel, missing the point of it all. Sometimes these same people unwittingly embarrass beginners at the clubs they regularly visit and so are helping to decrease numbers in the future.

Maybe now is the time to take a lesson from the past and promote "Back Your Club" once again; as the rewards that come from a happy club atmosphere are many for both caller and dancers. Perhaps with the increase in club memberships more people will care where square dancing is headed and everyone will benefit.

DANCING TIPS:

WHERE HAVE THEY GONE? (The Men)

We advertise . . . New beginners class starting. ??????

Result: Good attendance, but mostly ladies, very few men . . . We have one-night stands for various charitable reasons, we subscribe to good advertising. Result: Good attendance as expected — but mostly ladies.

CLUB NIGHTS: Attendance as expected . . . but where are the men?

This is a big problem, but it can be overcome, if the caller asks himself a few questions.

1. Do I particularly want to call a high level standard?
2. Do I wish to promote square dancing by starting a new class that registers mostly ladies?
3. Am I concerned about the age group?

These questions and many more can be real brain teasers. Let us take stock — Ladies are people — we want people. At the start of a new class, ladies should be asked, if they mind taking a gents part (with a little persuasion)? Explain to them that the level of dancing will not be hard — that they will be capable and above all will be able to fulfil their need to dance.

One must realize, that in a position like this, higher level dancing will be slowly achieved, and then again, who knows? But if we think a little and conclude that your class is DANCING, HAPPY, and ATTENDANCE is still well up — what more do we want?

The age group from 55 onwards are finding their way into square dancing, and the younger group are straying.

The future of square dancing rests with the Seniors — it is plain to see that dancing for FUN, FRIENDSHIP, HEALTH AND HAPPINESS is the main goal for all — now who wants to be in it?

WORKSHOP

Diagonal Pass Thru

The combination of Boys/Girls Diagonal Pass Thru can set up most of today's formations. In the sample routines below I have created the following formations:

— *Parallel RH or LH Ocean Waves*
normal facing lines, have the Boys or Girls Pass Thru

— *Parallel RH or LH Columns*
normal Boxes, have the Boys or Girls Pass Thru

— *Parallel 3 & 1 Lines*
normal Ocean Waves, have the centre Boys or Girls Pass Thru

— *Parallel Inverted Lines*
normal 3 & 1 Lines, have the infacing ends Pass Thru

— *Trade By Formation*
normal Columns, have the (trailing) Boys or Girls Pass Thru

Now check out the following sample routines (use your checkers first. Make sure you really understand the choreography!):
