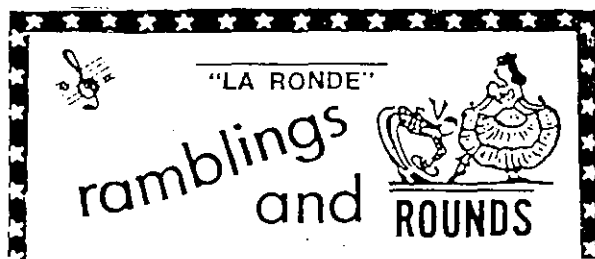

## FROM NEW SOUTH WALES

With this issue of "Review" comes a new look conception for this column. Co-ordinating Editor, Shirley Gibbs has been quietly doing the spadework and now it is all states GO!

We shall be getting, from each state in turn, items and on the spot reporting on Rounds and other news of interest. Many clubs bring out excellent newsy magazines that serve their members well. The big drawback, for the rest of us, much that would be of interest to all is lost to us because of very limited circulation. Hopefully with a nationwide network of contributors, we will be reading and learning a lot more activities and ideas of other areas.

A recent "success" story in N.S.W. The state Society runs a fifth Saturday dance open to all mainstream dancers. Sydney is a very large area from North to South — Neptune to West. Patronage depended largely on when and where suitable halls were available. The Central Coast has a considerable dancing population and with the Freeway, timewise, is easier to reach for city folk, than many parts of Sydney. The out of town choice was a happy and successful one. The R/D Council will stage a Sunday Matinee in the same area in May.

**Dancing:** It's fun, mentally stimulating, healthy — we read it so often without so much as a second thought. Just how healthy is it? Sadly (for health reasons), many have to limit or worse still, give up their dancing. The more fortunate can be thankful, a little more tolerant and take stock. Walking is a clear winner over jogging and running. Run 3km and expend around 150 calories or 630 kilojoules. Walk the same distance and, surprisingly we get the same result. It does take a little longer but we also observe a lot more on the way. Dancing and walking are much akin. One should check posture when walking (not ambling) just as when dancing, to gain benefit with legs, buttocks and tummy. You work it out — average dance is around two and half hours. How many km, kilojoules or calories plus the enjoyment of pleasant music and company of friends.

Happy dancing and remember the spotlight will be on your state too.

Dancers attending the National convention in Adelaide will be able to visit the National Society booth. At our booth you will be able to see the archives collection showing memorabilia of all the Australian National conventions. Our Historian, Marion Brown from Victoria, works very hard to keep all the information up to date and she would welcome any extra information anyone can give to her.

Also at our booth we have Australian travellers badges on sale. You may have seen dancers wearing Kangaroo's, Koala's and Platypuses and wondered where you can purchase them. Well this is your big chance, although most state bodies do carry a small stock of these badges.

To be eligible to buy one of these badges, you must have travelled the required distance to a Square dance. We are a trusting crowd and will take your word that you have travelled the distance and are eligible for the badge.

The travellers badges are for the distance you have travelled from your home to attend a Square Dance. The distances are 600km, 1500km and overseas. We also have what we call "give away badges". Now before you all rush to our booth for boxes of these, we do not give them away. They are very reasonably priced for you to buy so that you can give them away as a small gift when visiting a club overseas. This badge is in the Australian colours of green and gold and portrays a kangaroo, an emu, interlocking squares and the word Australia. What better gift could you want for an overseas square dance friend.

The travellers badges only cost \$6.00 and the giveaway badges are a mere \$2 each.

We wish each and every one of you attending the convention a safe journey and a great time of dancing with old friends and of making new friends.

## NEW BUSINESS

### OPERATIONS MANUAL

#### Round Dancing, Contra Dancing, and Clogging Details

##### 3) Amend clauses 116.8(g) and (h) to read:—

(g) The choice of Round Dance presented in the Showcase segment is the responsibility of each State Round Dance body, or the Australian Round Dance Association members of each State, or area presenting a dance.

(h) The Round Dance chosen shall be Phase Rated at below Roundalab Phase IV, and shall be taken from any of the following published lists:—

Roundalab Round of the Quarter

Callerlab Round of the Quarter

American Square Dance Magazine Round Dance Pulse Poll, Top Ten list published in the American "Round Dancer" Magazine, during the time frame of two months prior to the previous National to two months prior to this Convention.

##### 3) Insert new clause 116.8(i) as follows:—

The Selected Leader shall vet each selection to assure it has satisfied the requirements. A Round Dance submitted for the Showcase shall only be disallowed if either:—

a) it has already been submitted by another area, or

b) it does not satisfy the requirements as stated in clauses 116.8(d), 116.8(g) or 116.8(h).

##### Re-number old clause 116.8(i) to 116.8 (j)

Proposed: Queensland Round Dance Association Inc (Secretary — Linda Williamson).

##### 4) Replace clause 116.5(a) with the following:—

i) For a person to be eligible to Cue at a National Convention, he or she must meet the minimum requirements of an appropriate Australian Round Dance Association membership classification,

ii) Only Round Dance Leaders shall be permitted to Cue at the Main Round Dance Session, or any evening Brackets in the Main Hall. An additional prerequisite is that they shall have Cued to, at least, two previous National Conventions

iii) Only Round Dance Leaders or Teachers shall be permitted to Cue at any other Round Dance Sessions, evening half hour Round Dance Sessions in any hall, or evening brackets, where they are held in locations other than the Main Hall. An additional prerequisite is that they shall have Cued to, at least, one previous National Convention.

iv) Only Round Dance Leaders, Teachers, or Cuers shall be permitted to Cue at any afternoon, or morning Round Dance Brackets.

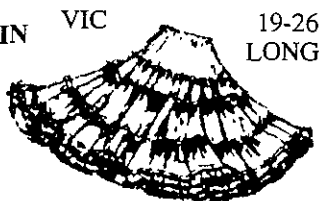

While cueing a random thought pops into one's head and throws one's concentration off. (This thought will always be a variation of what R.D. Cuers Hell is!)

When cueing and doing well, your partner (Note this could be anyone) comes up to you and starts talking. (Probably only to tell you how well you are doing.)

When using a hand microphone there will always be a spare person to dance with. When using a radio mic there will always be even couples.

After spending 20 minutes workshopping a complex sequence you go to the turntable only to find that you have left the record at home on the home unit where you had been practicing.

After cueing the same dance all day every day for 100 years you realize there is no such thing as RD Cuers Hell, you are only there to prove the existence of RD Dancers Hell and you instantly become a RDer yourself.

## R.D. DANCERS HELL IS:

There are 1000 rooms with continuous dancing to choose from. But as soon as you enter a room the current dance ends and a 1 hour rest starts.

Every Room you go into plays the same dance over and over.

Every Room plays the one R. Dance you hate.

Every Room plays a R. Dance that you know every step in except one, and every cue is late.

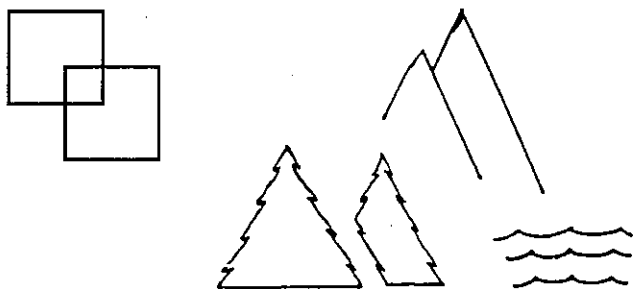
The one step you don't know is always being Workshopped in another room.

Once every 1000 years they restart the record of your favourite R.D. and 1/2 way through the last time through the sequence the cuer has a random thought about what R.D. Cuers Hell Is!!! So you decide to become a R.D. Cuer to make things better. (Go to Previous List)

So if you have sinned as a RDer or Cuer you now know what is in stall for you. Have a nice life, the alternative is HELLLLLL!

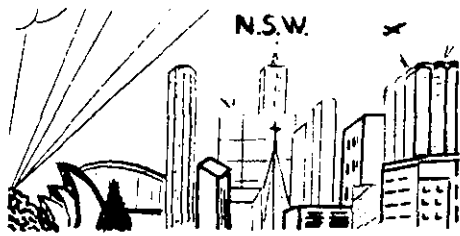

## WORKSHOP with ERIC WENDELL QUEENSLAND

**MAINSTREAM PROGRAM** Featuring TRADES. Although TRADE is a Basic call, I think that the application here is Mainstream. The idea to do this came from CALLERLINK, the Australian Caller's Federation Notes.

We normally think of using TRADES in Ocean Waves or as PARTNER TRADE. With a little bit of preparation, there are ways TRADES can be done very successfully from Lines Facing Out, e.g.

**ZERO LINE - PASS THRU - :**

GIRLS TRADE results in - Right Hand Ocean Waves

BOYS TRADE results in - Left Hand Ocean Waves

ENDS TRADE results in - 'Ends In' Inverted Lines

CENTRES TRADE results in - 'Ends Out' Inverted Lines

The first time you try this, use Boys and Girls Trade first, so that you can cue the action.

**ZERO LINE - PASS THRU - BOYS TRADE - GIRLS TRADE = 1/2 SASHAY** (Repeat this to return to **ZERO LINE**)

Then put the Boys or Girls on the Ends and call Ends Trade-Centres Trade

**ZERO BOX - SWING THRU - BOYS RUN - TAG THE LINE - FACE IN - PASS THRU - ENDS (Girls) TRADE - CENTRES (Boys) TRADE - PASS THRU ENDS (Girls) FOLD - STAR THRU - COUPLES CIRCULATE - FERRIS WHEEL CENTRES PASS THRU - LEFT ALLE**

### Example Figures

1. **ZERO LINE - PASS THRU - GIRLS TRADE - BOYS RUN - RIGHT & LEFT THRU - PASS THE OCEAN - BOYS CIRCULATE - RECYCLE - LEFT ALLE.**
