The Queensland Round Dance Association was formed due to the need for a body to coordinate the round dance activities within Queensland. This association has gone from strength to strength. It now has a badge, letterhead and its banner is on the drawing board. It has become an incorporated body. Our membership is open to all persons subscribing to the objects of the Association. It has ordinary Members, Teacher Members consisting of Leaders, Leader Partners, Teachers, Teacher Partners, Associate Teachers, Associate Teacher Partners and Cuers, Affiliate Members, Honorary Members and Life Members.

At the formation of the Association, a Standards Planning Committee was also formed. This committee is not deemed in any form to be a sub-committee of the Association and shall represent the Association as delegates in all discussions with other dance bodies. The Standard Planning Committee is made up of Leaders, Leader Partners, Teachers and Teacher Partners. One of the main duties of the Standards Planning Committee is to vet cue sheets to conform, where possible, with Roundalab standard terminology, but still maintaining the phase level as that originally set for the dance. This Committee has worked tirelessly for the last 2+ years and has now standardised the National Convention list. Now, at all combined functions, the cuers have agreed to use these standardised cues. What the cuers cue at their own clubs is their choice. The dancers are aware of these requirements and are very happy in the knowledge that the convention dances are going to be cued using the standard terminology. They do not have to spend all the dance time wondering what terminology the cuer is going to use.

A new sub-committee has just been formed within the Association. It will be known as the Northern Sub Committee. Nan Sapuppo will be its Chairperson. This Committee will be responsible for keeping the rest of the association in touch with the north and aware of their requirements and helping those in the north understand what the Association is planning and doing.

Preparations are well in hand for the visit of Bill & Helen Stairwalt in September. It is planned to have leader/teacher seminars and teach-sessions in different rhythms for both teachers and dancers.

The National Convention is here once again. What new Showcases will be added? Will the round dancers and teachers get to see what the States have chosen for their Showcase entry? What phase level will be imposed and will the Australian Round Dance Association work towards the betterment of round dancing for all and not just the selected few? An extract from the 1991 A.R.D.A. President's Report "Looking to the future. If people don't stop putting self interest first and start working for the good of the Association by following the rules, by making the rules for the good of the Association and following them and not trying to change them in a couple of years if it doesn't suit them, then the A.R.D.A. is doomed."

DANCING TIPS

by ERIC WENDELL . . . QLD

WHAT IS A BEGINNER? Beginner square dancers come in assorted sizes and varying ages. One could be a portly grandfather and another the skinny kid next door. Most of the males are good looking and all of the females are pretty. Some beginners take up square dancing to stop being pestered by their friends, even though they know it isn't for them. However they are good enough sports to admit they were wrong.

A beginner still thinks his caller is wonderful, never objects to taking his turn at kitchen duty, considers a visit to another club an outstanding event and finds an evening of square dancing for a couple of dollars is a bargain.

If his square breaks down a beginner will often apologize rather than start telling the other seven people where they went wrong. Most beginners confess that they have one disability — two left feet. Oddly enough they do not seem to notice that this is offset by their two right hands . . . Both handicaps disappear around the twelfth lesson.

A beginner is old-fashioned. He thinks he should attend class as regularly as possible, arrive on time and stop talking when the caller is explaining something. A beginner has the enthusiasm of a press agent, the dedication of the Pony Express, the spontaneity of a surprise party and the eagerness of a puppy . . . A beginner was no doubt the original inspiration for the expression — "SQUARE DANCERS ARE NICE PEOPLE".
