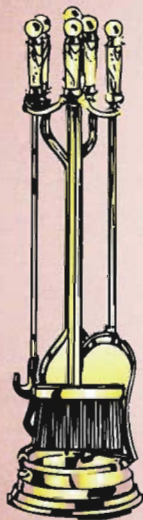

## Dancing with Dozy

Nine of us from three states just completed a caller school with Brian Hotchkies at Casino—undoubtedly the friendliest town in Australia.

It was a worry!

I suppose it doesn't matter if your caller is a lady but how do you feel about dancing to a guy who plays with dolls? We did that a lot at Casino.

Table-top dancers are a bit like voodoo dolls—little wooden dominos that represent a square. We move them around to check out new choreography. If you found your legs twitching and jerking while you were trying to sleep it was probably because one of us was thinking about you while we were working late.

Brian gave us a lot of short cuts for using the dolls so if your caller comes back and starts calling things like, "Turn your back on your partner," he just means "square thru" and if he says, "spread the wave, move the ends to the furthest centre and reverse the new ends" you just do a normal swing thru and everything will flow along nicely. Give us time. We'll get back to the real world.

But there was a lot of magic on the

course and we learned a brand new call that will forever save callers the ignominy of admitting they messed up. In my crystal ball I can see next year's National in Hobart. The floor is irretrievably broken down when the caller cries, *Abracadabra*, and, whammo! everybody rushes back to their home position. Caller Lab will love it!

That wasn't the only new call. Did you know there's a standard move called *The Guillotine*? Most callers prefer "Heads roll away," but you get the idea.

Wilma Flannery was there, too, and called a segment of contras. Everyone enjoyed it even if a few were reluctant at first. We were all, of course, receptive to square dancing but soon realised that Wilma is contra-ceptive.

To all the gang on the course, to Val, Irene, Lesley & Beverly, and to people like Barbara, Robert, Trish, Des and the rest who came along so often to make up a square for us to practise with let me say thank you for a wonderful week. You were just like family. And, you can breathe easily—your secrets are safe with me.

## The Strawberry Festival Returns

The Strawberry Festival has been an integral part of the Square Dance calendar in Queensland since the mid 70's through to the mid 90's. It was originally started in the Redlands area to coincide with the Redland's Shire Strawberry Festival. Historically the Redlands area was an area renowned for agriculture and affectionately known as the Salad Bowl belt, given the high density and quality of the fruit and vegetables in the area. Through the retirement from calling by The Salad Bowl Squares founders, Peter and Ev Johnson, the Strawberry Festival sadly disappeared from the Square dancing scene in Brisbane.

The quality and calibre of the callers who have been invited to call this weekend in the past have been many of the World's top callers. Many of today's local callers and dancers saw the Strawberry Festival as an inspirational and exciting event that, for many years, was one of Brisbane's premier square dance

weekends.

This year marks the return of the Strawberry Festival with guest caller Mike Davey from Victoria. Together with Salad Bowl Squares resident club caller Jason Dean they have forged a formidable partnership that has seen them become the first Australian callers to have been invited to call in Japan. On several occasions they have teamed up to call at the Armidale Festival along with other feature weekends and festivals around the country. Mike and Jason again take the stage to plant the seed of regrowth in a new Strawberry Festival era.

Next year sees the return to the Strawberry Festival of Mike Seastrom (the Singing Dentist) Mike is one of the world's top callers having called in most square dancing countries around the world and having recorded some of the most popular and enduring square dance songs on Rhythm and Global records. ### EMERGENCY CALL FOR MEDICAL AID



- 1 When a dancer goes down, a second dancer attends him/her.
- 2 Remaining couples join hands and take a step backward. This will allow the injured person and attendant air and room.
- 3 Raise joined hands as high as possible in the form of an arched circle.
- 4 On seeing this signal, the caller or hall monitor will immediately place an Emergency Call for Medical Aid.
