AUSTRALIAN CALLERS FEDERATION REPORT (ACF)

Hi there. For my 1st report I thought I'd send in an update received from Callerlab RE: The Lost Squares procedure (See below). The ACF board played an active role in the review & re-circulation of this procedure world-wide. Watch out for my next report – "Introducing the ACF Board members".

'LOST SQUARES PROCEDURE'

In 1986 CALLERLAB introduced a procedure for 'LOST SQUARES'. It was approved with some small changes in 1987 and has now been revised. CALLERLAB recommends that dancers use the following Patter and Singing Call Procedures to help lost squares quickly resume dancing. Callers should teach these procedures to their dancers and be alert for sets waiting to re-enter the action and for sets struggling with singing calls.

HOEDOWN PROCEDURE - Make Normal Lines, Wait for Entry, and Sort during Promenade
The following procedure is intended for use during Patter or Hoedown calling when longer sequences are likely and at least half the square is confused. If only one or two dancers are lost then they should look for a helpful hand and attempt to fill the vacant spots within the still functioning square.

DANCER'S RESPONSIBILITY

1. If dancers in a confused but partially functioning square hear "Make Normal Lines", then lost dancers should quickly adjust to Normal Couples (Boy left, Girl right) ready to join the forming Normal (Boy -Girl-Boy-Girl) Facing Lines.
2. In the case of total breakdown each dancer should return to home position as soon as possible. Then the head ladies join hands with their corner and the head couples back out to form normal lines at the sides of the square.
3. On the caller's command, "Normal Lines, Go Forward and Back", all lost squares enter into the dance pattern. If a resolution is heard first, then dancers in lost squares should simply readjust to a squared set.
4. Dancers in a lost square must remember that re-entering from normal lines does not guarantee a correct resolution. Full recovery will probably require rapid sorting to home during the Promenade (move counter-clockwise but step out at your home).

CALLER'S RESPONSIBILITY

1. Recognize that a number of sets have broken down and have formed lines.
2. Place the dancing squares into facing lines that are in a normal BGBG arrangement (#0L).
3. Give the command "NORMAL LINES, Go Forward and Back" in a bold voice, which is the command for the lost squares to enter into the dance pattern.
4. Allow enough time during the Promenade for squares that were lost to complete their Promenade and sort as necessary to get home. If an "at home" resolution is used, make sure all the sets are squared up.

SINGING CALL PROCEDURE - Swing, and Men Sort during Promenade

The following procedure is intended for use during a Singing Call where the sequences are short and closely timed to the music. The minimum needed to avoid more confusion and resume dancing at the next sequence is each man at home with some lady for a partner.

DANCER'S RESPONSIBILITY

Since partners probably should be changing, dancers in a lost square should be ready for a quick Swing with their corner or nearest opposite sex and then expect to make adjustments during the Promenade so that the men end at home. If still lost during the Promenade, men should quickly head for home while ladies should join the closest un-partnered man.

CALLER'S RESPONSIBILITY

In the case of significant breakdown on the floor, adjust the choreography or provide more clues and cues to improve the success rate on the next figure.

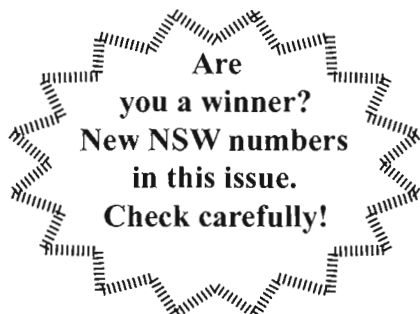

AROUND THE SQUARE

VARIATIONS ON THE 2 FACED LINE SET UP.

Once you feel confident with the above method and need a little more variations and you are taking less time in matching up your couples, try these:

To the point of obtaining your Secondary Lady in the same 2 Faced Line, [step 2 D] instead of WHEEL & DEAL Call BEND THE LINE.

- 1: IF YOUR SECONDARY COUPLE **IS** MATCHED UP,
You will have a **Zero Line**, or a RIGHT & LEFT THRU from a **Zero Line**.

[your secondary couple to the left of your Key couple]
NOW CALL YOUR FAVOURITE GET OUTS FROM A ZERO LINE.

- 2: IF YOUR SECONDARY COUPLE **IS NOT** MATCHED UP,
Call: **Pass The Ocean, Recycle**.
a: If your Key couple is on the outside, your get out is AL.
b: If your Key couple is on the inside, your get out is, Right & left Thru, AL.

OR
Dive Thru, Square Thru 3, AL.

- 3: IF YOUR SECONDARY COUPLE IS **NOT** MATCHED UP,
Call: **Pass Thru, Wheel & Deal**.
a: If your Key couple is on the outside, Call: Centres Pass Thru, AL
b: If your Key couple is on the inside, Call: Zoom, Centres Pass Thru, AL.

Tips for using this sight resolution method.

1: Follow the system exactly as is until you become comfortable with it. You will eventually find short cuts and other variations which you can use that will bring you to a Left Allemande even faster, but do not try to rush into these. Get completely confident with the basic system so that you can always fall back on it if you get into trouble with variations.

2: Do not practice this for the first time at a regular or open dance. If you make a mistake because the procedure is new to you, it will cause you to lose confidence. Practice it with one square at home, or if you have understanding members, try it out at your Club first.

3: You should establish a Primary and Secondary couples in at least 3 squares. The odds of three squares breaking down at the same time are rather remote. If you choose 2 squares, the odds are much greater for both to break down at the same time. If you only choose 1 square you are asking for trouble.

4: During the course of the dance, you may forget who the people are and get them to the wrong corner. This is not a crime and don't worry about it as long as IT DOES NOT HAPPEN TOO OFTEN. Most dancers enjoy having the Caller make the occasional mistake. It shows that they are only human and it also helps to establish greater rapport with the floor.

Note. If you happen to forget who the Primary and Secondary couples are as you are calling, you can usually save yourself by the following method: Ask one man who his corner is. [Just say over the mike: Jim, who's your corner?] The man you asked now becomes your Primary couple, and the girl he points to is part of the Secondary couple. Now follow the system to get everyone to an AL. This works very well at your home club where you know all the dancers. This can also work with a floor of strangers as long as you know one couple on the floor you can call upon.

One method that I use is writing down on a piece of paper who the people are: e.g., Jack & Jill and Bill & Mary. If on a strange floor, you can write: Blue shirt with Yellow Skirt and White shirt with Black Hair. It does not matter what you use as long as YOU can recognise it.

Finally: This sight resolution will always work no matter what you have called up to the point you begin to use it. The only time it will not work is if you use oddball calls such as: 1 & 2 Right & Left Thru or: 3 & 4 Ladies Chain etc.

After you get used to this system, you will see a number of short cuts. These are not mentioned here, as it is important that you learn the basics first. Once you are competent and comfortable with this system, you should then, at any given moment be able to get the square to an AL in 15 seconds or less, or even have them get out to home.

SOUTH AUSTRALIAN PRESIDENT'S REPORT

- 1** When a dancer goes down, a second dancer attends him/her.
- 2** Remaining couples join hands and take a step backward. This will allow the injured person and attendant air and room.
- 3** Raise joined hands as high as possible in the form of an arched circle.
- 4** On seeing this signal, the caller or hall monitor will immediately place an Emergency Call for Medical Aid.
