The Mackay & District Square Dancing Club proudly presented the Martin Klibbe Memorial Weekend. A Mackay Festival of Arts Event, targeting the young and the young at heart, on the weekend of 15/16/17 July 2005.

Dancers came from all over - Adelaide, Melbourne, Brisbane, Logan, Sunshine Coast, Proston, Bundaberg, Townsville, and Rockhampton. The Featured Caller was Jeff Seidel from Adelaide. Unfortunately Brett Gill from Sydney was unable to attend due to a family illness. Callers included Kevin Clive from Townsville; Michael and Matthew Mills from Bundaberg; southern Queensland callers, Graham Rigby, Rod Dinte, Peter Clarke; Laurie Miles and Rob Fry from Rockhampton; and Mackay Caller Owen Klibbe, who has returned to the microphone following the death of Martin to fill the loss when able. Rounds were cued on the Saturday evening by Jane Rayner, replacing Julie Jensen who was unable to attend because of a family illness. After an introduction to square dancing on Saturday morning at the Festival of Arts, some new dancers were gained and a few of those dancers traveled out to the dance on Saturday evening.

Saturday evening commenced with the playing of Advance Australia Fair. Official Guests included Martin's former bosses, Hon. De-Anne Kelly, MP Federal Member for Dawson, Minister for Veteran's Affairs and Minister assisting the Minister for Defence; Ted Malone MP Member for Mirani Deputy Opposition Whip and Shadow Minister for Local Government and Planning; Martin's best friend, Councillor George Christensen, Division 7 Mackay City Council; Leighton Bloomfield, President of the Square Dancing Society of Queensland Inc.; and Rod Dinte, Treasurer of the Queensland Callers Assn. The highlight of the evening was the Dedication, where Martin's photo appeared on the large television screen and the dancers danced to Martin calling Moody Blues. During his speech George has indicated that he will do his best to ensure that this successful dance continues as part of the Festival of Arts. Numbers show nine sets of dancers and twenty-five non dancers were in attendance on the Saturday evening. Jeff ran a very informative Callers' Forum on the Saturday afternoon. The "Martin Klibbe Memorial Dance" Banner was well photographed during the weekend. The likeness to Martin is unreal. On Sunday about sixty dancers attended the Sausage Sizzle.

Wednesday's paper showed a photo printed of the dancers dancing on the World Bizarre Stage during the Festival of Arts. Perfect weather and direct flights contributed to the large attendance and I am sure Martin would have been pleased at the success of the weekend. Many dancers paid a visit to the cemetery to see Martin's newly completed headstone on his grave. It is a unique headstone. The only one like it in Australia - it is a tribute to what Martin was passionate about his country Australia and the Australian flag.

## AROUND THE SQUARE

This month lets look at Fractions. Fractions can and do cause confusion.  
How far is a  $\frac{1}{4}$ ,  $\frac{1}{2}$ ,  $\frac{3}{4}$  ?

$\frac{1}{4}$ ,  $\frac{1}{2}$ ,  $\frac{3}{4}$ , and full are words that a caller will use a lot during teaching & calling.  
How far is a  $\frac{1}{4}$  ?

Imagine that you are standing in the middle of a square room with your back to the caller and you are facing the far end. You can think of a compass or a clock if you like. It does not matter as long as you can understand it.

The far [back] wall could be 12 o'clock, or North.

If you turn a  $\frac{1}{4}$  right, you will be facing a side wall which would be 3 o'clock or East or 90%..

If you turn a  $\frac{1}{2}$ , you will be facing the front wall [caller] or 6 o'clock or South and you would have done 180%.

If you turn  $\frac{3}{4}$  right, you would be facing a side wall or 9 o'clock or West and you would have done 270%.

From here it is easy to see that if you do a full turn, that will put you back to your starting position.

Heads/Sides promenade  $\frac{1}{4}$  or  $\frac{1}{2}$  or  $\frac{3}{4}$  will put you where? Think about it.

There are movements that tell you to go  $\frac{1}{4}$  more or sweep  $\frac{1}{4}$ . These are dependent on the action taken by the previous call. In other words, you are to move or turn in the direction that is established by the previous movement.

Lets look at Flutter Wheel. It starts with two facing couples, the direction of the lady's movement to pick up the opposite gent is clockwise, so when the call sweep a  $\frac{1}{4}$  is given, the direction of the sweep will be clockwise and the amount of turn will be  $\frac{1}{4}$ .

Now lets look at Right & Left Thru. Again we start with facing couples. The call is Right & Left Thru, and a  $\frac{1}{4}$  more. The action here is anti clockwise, as you curtesy turn the lady with an arm around her waist, you are turning to your left or anti clockwise, therefore a  $\frac{1}{4}$  more would be to your left or anti clockwise, and you will end up in a two faced line.

Whether you determine your facing directions by a clock, compass or a protractor, how far to turn is an important lesson to learn in Square Dancing.

\*Please note; digital watches don't help and are no good for this exercise.

## “THE ASHGROVE ROSEBOWL STORY”

When square dancing swept across Australia in the early “fifties” as social phenomena never seen before or since, whole families and communities became so involved that, in Brisbane, one sixth of our entire population was dancing at least several times a week.

The “Elimination Hoedown” , in keeping with our indomitable sporting spirit, was everywhere and in 1955, our “S-Bar-B” club invited sets to compete for the brand new “Ashgrove Rosebowl” trophy and a friendly “battle royale” ensued with the “four leaf clover” edging out the “Bar O’H Jets” and the “Sunflower Square”.

In order to broaden future contests, couples were then invited to nominate and were drawn by ballot into sets and positions in those sets, the responsibility of the caller (yours truly) being to eliminate them, set by set, ultimately producing a winner - this format continuing right through to the present time.

Calling for the “Rosebowl” has always been limited to just twenty basic movements, but with almost unlimited variations in choreography, the excitement has always been intense with square dancing “at its most cutting edge”.

The years have rolled on with the original trophy now greatly enhanced by its mounting on a large elegant new base, thanks to our bus historian, Graham Norman.

The names of previous winners over five decades have been engraved on plates attached to the base of the trophy which, at first glance, could almost be regarded as the “Davis Cup” of square dancing! From our first “Rosebowl”, when in driving rain, dancers streamed off trams to pack St. Barnabas Hall right through to personalities like Alan Evans and Leighton Bloomfield involved in today’s highest dance levels, yet intensely keen rivals when it comes to the “Rosebowl”.

It’s simply become an institution – unique in the wonderful world of square dancing.

So why then is our fiftieth “Ashgrove Rosebowl” at St. Barnabas Hall the “finale”? Very simply, our magnificent trophy is now “full” with no more provision for winners’ names – our “race is run” and yet another chapter is about to complete in the annals of square dancing in Queensland.

Our sincere thanks to my “best mate”, Rod McLachlan, for his inimitable, intense judging over many years; Graham Norman more recently; and Bill McCoy who has so professionally recorded the contest for so long.

“Square dancing will be the winner!!!”

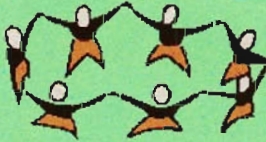

### EMERGENCY CALL FOR MEDICAL AID



- 1** When a dancer goes down, a second dancer attends him/her.
- 2** Remaining couples join hands and take a step backward. This will allow the injured person and attendant air and room.
- 3** Raise joined hands as high as possible in the form of an arched circle.
- 4** On seeing this signal, the caller or hall monitor will immediately place an Emergency Call for Medical Aid.
