## Round Dance News From The National-your Input Requested

We have seen the Round Dancing done at the various Square Dances, whether it is your weekly club dance or a major festival. But how much do you know about the way the dance appeared on the program in the first place?

At the major festivals the material is mostly taken from the National List. This list is broken up in three categories. The Category A dances are the ones that have been selected as being most suitable for the square dancer who doesn't necessarily Round Dance all the time. Category A dances are those which are no greater than Phase 3, and can only be Two Step, Waltz, Rumba, Cha Cha, or Foxtrot. Previously this was limited to only Two Step and Waltz, so why the new rhythms?

Rumba – the timing is the same as Two Step, but with a different feel. This is a great rhythm for contrasting the music to either Waltz or Two Step. The music can be either something with a real Latin flavour or some of the slower country music.

Cha – at this level the steps are exactly the same as rumba except with that cha, cha, cha count at the end of each measure. A dance is a real good way of boosting the atmosphere in a Round Dance bracket.

Foxtrot – the movements at this level are exactly the same as Waltz, but with a different timing. The choice of music is endless. With this rhythm you can use music with that big band sound or the crooners like Dean Martin, Bobby Darin, or Nat King Cole.

But how do the different dances either come onto the list? Every year, every caller (as well as the cuers) have the opportunity to vote material onto the list at the Showcase Session. So it is so very important that the callers and dancers attend and vote at the Showcase Session at our Nationals.

Currently ARDA is calling for your help to create a supplement to the National List called the Dancers List. The list will initially be set at 40 dances and this number will be reviewed. The rhythms for this list are to be from Twostep, Waltz and Five-Count only. This list will be updated through the National Convention, so please put forward your suggestions as it is from the dancers we are hoping to find new material. If you hear or dance something you really like, then talk to your caller or cuer. All they need is the name of the dance and they can simply contact any of the ARDA committee members with the details. If you'd like to collate your own ideas to send in to ARDA then a Dancer

## Square Dance Members Personal Accident Insurance

The Society has arranged insurance with Lloyds of London through their Sports-cover Syndicate to provide accidental injury protection for members. The insurance covers members while at or travelling to or from Society dances, activities, functions, demonstrations, administration and meetings etc, anywhere in Australia. When members represent the Society overseas they also have similar coverage. Please note that the insurance covers MEMBERS ONLY and does not cover non member casual dancers so you must keep your membership current to have continuity of insurance.

### POLICY BENEFITS.

In the event of a member sustaining an accidental injury in the course of the activities outlined above then a range of benefits are covered:

# LUMP SUM injury benefits are payable on a sliding scale up to \$30,000 for death or permanent paraplegia or quadraplegia with lesser sums payable for benefits like loss of limbs, body organs, sight, hearing, disfigurement etc.

# MEDICAL, Private Hospital, Ambulance, Physiotherapy and various other treatment expenses resulting from the injury are insured however the benefit is generally limited to 80% of the bill and all claims must first go to Medicare, Healthcare Fund, Motor Injury (third party) insurer or any other insurer or scheme providing cover that applies to the injury.

# Square Dance Members Personal Accident Insurance Continued

Our policy then pays some of the gap between payments by any other insurers and the total treatment related bills.

# FUNERAL EXPENSES in the event of death due to accidental injury are covered to a \$5,000 limit.

# Minor Benefits provided, such as loss of income if you are working, bed care, rehabilitation, home renovation etc, have some coverage subject to specific policy sub limits and restrictions which are too numerous for inclusion in this article.

## WHAT IS NOT COVERED?

Within the major policy exclusions the policy does not insure:

- Sickness and disease, e.g. heart attack or fainting spell, intentional self injury.
- injuries arising out of the use of alcohol or drugs.
- injuries arising out of mental sickness, depression, emotional disorders, nervous anxiety and stress related conditions.
- various others such as injuries arising out of war, terrorism.

## HOW TO MAKE A CLAIM.

If you are unfortunate enough to suffer an injury covered by this policy then you must:

- \* Advise the Society promptly as they must notify insurers of the claim within 30 days to ensure that it proceeds.
- \* You will then be sent a claim form with instructions on how to complete and return it.
- \* Documents must be kept to justify the claim such as all medical and other expense bills, doctors certificates and other relevant information.
- \* The claim will be settled or a progress payment made once insurers have the required documents.

Please appreciate that this is but a short overview of an extensive policy wording and you should refer to square dance administration for full details of all the small print and coverage that may apply to a particular claim event.

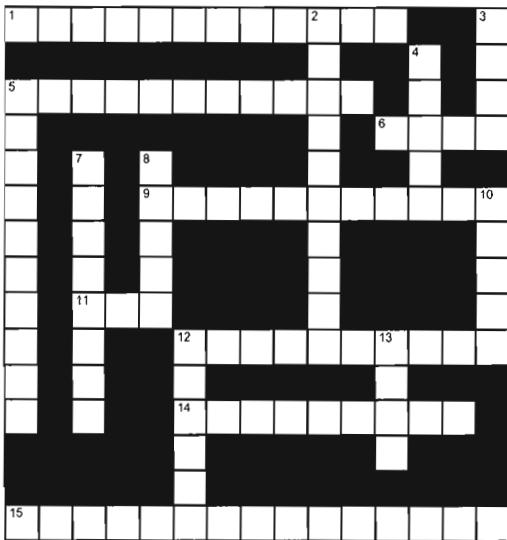

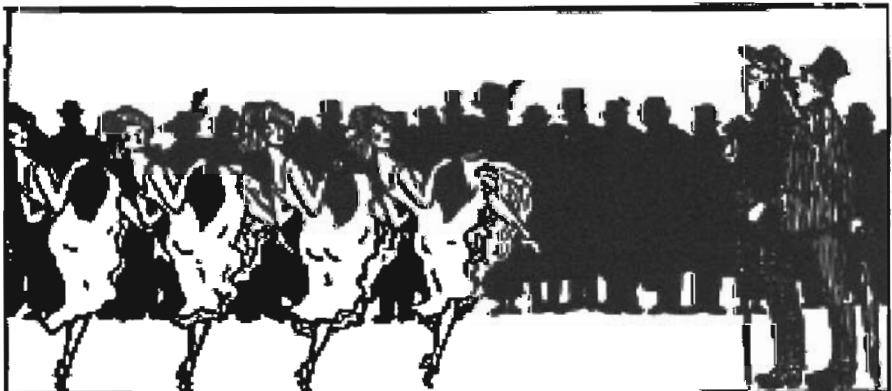


Appropriate French music was played between the Square Dancing which included the special move GUILLOTINE - defined as HEADS ROLLAWAY.

# How Square Dancing began in North Queensland

In 1971 Graham Rigby came on regular visits to Ayr sponsored by the then national fitness club in the Burdekin. Late in 1971 after a year of successful regular visits with good attendances, Graham suggested we form our own square dance club. A meeting was held at the NFC hall in Wickham St Ayr and the Burdekin Square Dance Club was formed.

1st president - Bill Davies

1st secretary - Judy Peterson

1st treasurer - Fred Marshall

Publicity Officer & teacher -- Shirley Gauvin

Bill Davies was only able to be president for a short time due to a sudden deterioration in his health and Jim Gauvin became the first long serving president - remaining in that position unopposed until 1975.

1972 After a year of regular dancing and promotion our club decided to adopt a name more relevant to square dancing. A competition was held among members and after many great suggestions were entered by both senior and junior members the name "Ayr Allemanders Square Dance Club" was chosen and formally adopted at the Annual General Meeting in March 1972. The Ayr Allemanders also applied for and gained affiliation with the Queensland Square Dance Society at this time. All officers and any members who cared to register for same began receiving the Society's newspaper "South Pacific Square Dance Review" on a regular basis. The Club also received copies of the Minutes of all the State Society's meetings. Ayr Allemanders appointed Mr. Graham Rigby and Eric Wendell as it proxies at these meetings in Brisbane.

Our club at this time was learning from records made by Graham Rigby and Ron Jones with the steps being taught by Shirley Gauvin. Regular visits by Graham Rigby and Eric Wendell were very welcome to give us experience in dancing to live calling.

In January 1973 Shirley Gauvin and her son Don from the teenage group went to the annual Tallebudgerra Summer Holiday Camp to learn more about the dancing and to get more teaching material as well as promoting our Club's existence. After this we began to get visits from more high profile callers including Sid & Betty Leighton and Nev & Bev McLaughlin, Eric and Graham also continued their regular visits. In September - Shirley Gauvin went to Brisbane for a week of dancing and teaching experience and was invited to dance in the combined clubs display at the Toowoomba Carnival of Flowers.

### EMERGENCY CALL FOR MEDICAL AID



- 1 When a dancer goes down, a second dancer attends him/her.
- 2 Remaining couples join hands and take a step backward. This will allow the injured person and attendant air and room.
- 3 Raise joined hands as high as possible in the form of an arched circle.
- 4 On seeing this signal, the caller or hall monitor will immediately place an Emergency Call for Medical Aid.
